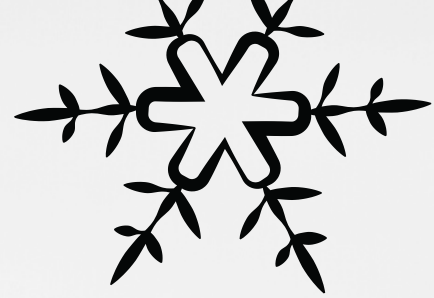


The Campaign


